Training Courses 2021

We will hopefully be running our training classes this year (subject to restrictions). Training classes take place at Westhide Estate, about 5 miles north-east of Hereford. Our Trainers are volunteers and the guidance and advice they give is based on personal experiences and achievements. If you can commit to dummy throwing at a class for the whole 8-week training course your training fee will be waived. The Training fee is £60 per dog (8-week course). Training takes place in small groups of up to 6 people: Puppy (up to 18 months at end of course), Foundation, Intermediate, Novice, Open.

You will require a lead, whistle (attached to a lanyard), dummy bag and poo bags. Your dog should be able to: walk to heel on a loose lead without pulling, do a simple recall, sit quietly/sit and stay off lead (no noise, whining, barking or interfering with other dogs). Please contact us if you would like to take part in the training or would like more information.


